The anterior wall to the apex is akinetic (4 chamber view, upper left), the anterolateral wall akinetic from midwall to apex (5 chamber view, upper right) and the inferior wall (2 chamber view, lower left), inferoseptum (4 chamber view, upper left and inferolateral wall (apical long axis view, lower right) are also involved. This was a large LAD that wrapped around the apex and also supplied the distal inferior wall.
