Calculus (lat. calculus, Diminutiv von calx, -Stein, Plural: calculi) Ursprung: aus dem Lateinischen, wörtlich „kleiner Kieselstein“ (als Rechenstein, beispielsweise bei einem Abakus verwendet). Calculus (from Latin calculus, literally 'small pebble', used for counting and calculations, as on an abacus) is the mathematical study of continuous change, in the same way that geometry is the study of shape and algebra is the study of generalizations of arithmetic operations. Scope. Matrix calculus refers to a number of different notations that use matrices and vectors to collect the derivative of each component of the dependent variable with respect to each component of the independent variable.
